F. REQUIREMENTS AND SUBSTANTIATING INFORMATION

The following are requirements for the application:

- Applicants must be a Minnesota resident enrolled in a MT/CLS/MLS or MLT/CLT school accredited by NAACLS or CAAHEP. Or a Minnesota resident enrolled in an accredited NAACLS or CAAHEP SBB program.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Applicant's course of study must lead to a career in one of the disciplines recognized by MNABB.
- Applicants pursuing careers other than those recognized by MNABB will NOT be considered or accepted.
- Applicant must provide evidence of financial need and career goals and may only use the award to defray tuition costs.

The following substantiating information must be submitted with the application:

- Official transcript of grades from colleges attended.
- Two letters of personnel reference. These individuals can not be family members.
- A separate typed essay (500 words or less) stating why you have chosen this career.
- The application, transcripts, letters of recommendation, and personnel essay must be submitted and mailed as one complete package.

G. PROCEDURES

Application must be completed and filed prior to July 1 to be considered for the current year's scholarship. Applications that are incomplete or received after the deadline will not be considered.

Please note that all applicants and supporting documents will be considered as confidential information by MNABB and will be destroyed after consideration.

The MNABB scholarship committee, whose decision will be final, will determine scholarship recipients. Only the recipients will be notified. Three \$250.00 scholarships will be awarded annually.

Winners will be notified and thereafter will furnish proof of being either a student in good standing or enrolled for entrance into the fall program of the accredited school.
